HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 391

May 11, 2026

The Board of Directors (the “Board”) of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 391 (the “District”) met in regular session in person and by videoconference, open to the public, on the 11th day of May, 2026, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Houston, Texas, outside the boundaries of the District, and the roll was called of the members of the Board:

and all of the above were present except Director Gibbons, thus constituting a quorum.

Also present at the meeting were Sergeant Pleytez and Lieutenant Rodriguez of the Harris County Constables; Megan Jacob, Paul Jacob, and Tory Johnson, residents of the District attending by videoconference; Avni Patel of Forvis Mazars, LLP (“Forvis”); Danae Dehoyos and Simon VanDyk of Touchstone District Services; Cole Caraway of LJA Engineering (“LJA”); Demitra Berry of McLennan & Associates, LP (“McLennan”); Stephanie Lee of KGA/Deforest Design, LLC (“KGA”); Debbie Arellano of Bob Leared Interests; Andrew Valladares of Double Oak Erosion; Randy Davila of Inframark Water & Infrastructure Services (“Inframark”); and Greer Pagan, Elizabeth Cone, and Kerri Houck of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP (“ABHR”).

2026 DIRECTORS ELECTION

ORDER CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF DIRECTORS ELECTION

The Board reviewed the certified returns from Election Officials for the District’s May 2, 2026, Directors Election. Mr. Pagan presented an Order Canvassing the Returns and Declaring Results of Directors Election, reflecting that the election resulted favorably for the following, as indicated in the certified returns:

Director Porter, President of the Board, noted the completion of the canvass of the returns of the election pursuant to Section 67.004(g), Texas Election Code. After review and discussion, Director Porter moved to adopt the Order Canvassing the Returns and Declaring Results of Directors Election and direct that the Order be filed appropriately and retained in the District’s official records. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION

The Board considered approving a Certificate of Election, reflecting the election of Carol Gibbons, Chris McWilliams, and Myla Lettries to the Board of Directors of the District each for a four-year term. Following review and discussion, Director Blackwell moved to (1) approve the Certificate of Election; and (2) direct that all of the documents be filed appropriately and retained in the District’s official records. Director Porter seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

DIRECTORS’ SWORN STATEMENTS, BONDS, AND OATHS OF OFFICE

Mr. Pagan reviewed the Sworn Statements and Oaths of Office for Directors Gibbons, McWilliams, and Lettries. Following review and discussion, Director Blackwell moved to (1) approve the Sworn Statements, Official Bond, and Oaths of Office; and (2) direct that all of the documents be filed appropriately and retained in the District’s official records. Director Porter seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

AUTHORIZE PAYMENT TO ELECTION OFFICIALS

The Board considered authorizing payment to election officials for the 2026 Directors Election. Following discussion, Director Blackwell moved to authorize

payment to election officials. Director Porter seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

REORGANIZE THE BOARD

The Board considered reorganizing and Director McWilliams moved to appoint Director Gibbons as President. Director Lettries seconded the motion, which did not pass with Directors Porter and Blackwell voting against the motion.

Following additional review and discussion, Director Blackwell then moved to reorganize the Board as following:

Director Porter seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

DISTRICT REGISTRATION FORM

The Board deferred action on this item.

OPEN MEETINGS ACT AND PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Mr. Pagan next reviewed a memorandum regarding Texas Open Meetings Act and Public Information Act training requirements for Directors and encouraged Directors Gibbons, McWilliams, and Lettries to receive their training as soon as possible and to forward their certificates of completion to ABHR for inclusion in the District's permanent records.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST DISCLOSURE REQUIRED UNDER CHAPTER 176 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, INCLUDING REVIEW OF DISCLOSURE FORMS ADOPTED BY THE TEXAS ETHICS COMMISSION AND LIST OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICERS

Mr. Pagan reviewed with the Board legislation enacting Chapter 176 of the Texas Local Government Code, which requires directors and consultants to disclose certain conflicts of interest. Mr. Pagan reviewed with the Board the forms adopted by the Texas Ethics Commission for making disclosures under Chapter 176 and noted that the forms are required to be filed with the records administrator for the District. Mr. Pagan encouraged Directors Gibbons, McWilliams, and Lettries to contact ABHR if assistance is

needed in determining whether a conflict requires disclosure or in making a required disclosure.

CYBERSECURITY AND ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Mr. Pagan reviewed a memorandum regarding annual cybersecurity and artificial intelligence training requirements for local government employees and elected and appointed officials. He stated that the required training should be completed and reported to ABHR prior to the August 31st deadline for reporting compliance to the Texas Department of Information Resources ("DIR"). After review and discussion, the Board directed the required persons to complete their certified training programs and report their completion to ABHR for reporting to DIR by August 31st.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

The Board opened the meeting for public comments.

Mr. Jacob congratulated the new Board members on being elected. He then stated concerns regarding the agreement with the development adjacent to the District, also known as Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 592 ("HCMUD No. 592").

There being no further public comments, the Board moved to the next agenda item.

MINUTES

The Board considered approving the minutes of the April 13, 2026, regular meeting and the April 21, 2026, special meeting. After review and discussion, Director Blackwell moved to approve the minutes, as presented. Director Porter seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

SECURITY MATTERS

Sergeant Pleytez and Lieutenant Rodriguez updated the Board on security matters in the District.

AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR END MAY 31, 2026

The Board discussed engagement of Forvis for fiscal year end May 31, 2026. Ms. Patel requested approval of the engagement letter with an estimated fee of \$24,900 plus expenses to complete audit of the District's financial records for the fiscal year end May 31, 2026. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to approve the fiscal year end audit proposal from Forvis. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT GUIDELINES AND DIRECTOR EXPENSES FOR ASSOCIATION OF WATER BOARD DIRECTORS (“AWBD”) SUMMER CONFERENCE

Mr. Pagan discussed the District’s Travel Reimbursement Guidelines (the “Guidelines”) in connection with the upcoming AWBD summer conference, and discussion ensued regarding specific expenses eligible and ineligible for the conference.

FINANCIAL AND BOOKKEEPING MATTERS

Ms. Berry reviewed the bookkeeper’s report, a copy of which is attached, and presented the District’s bills for payment. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to approve the bookkeeper’s report and payment of the District’s bills. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

ADOPT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR END MAY 31, 2027

Ms. Berry reviewed a draft budget for the fiscal year end May 31, 2027, a copy of which is attached to the bookkeeper’s report. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to adopt the proposed budget for the fiscal year end May 31, 2027, as amended. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

TAX ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTIONS MATTERS

Ms. Arellano reviewed the tax assessor/collector’s report, delinquent tax report, and checks presented for payment from the tax account. A copy of the tax assessor/collector’s report is attached. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to approve the tax assessor/collector’s report and payment of the bills from the tax account. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

NEW DEVELOPMENT ADJACENT TO DISTRICT

Mr. Pagan updated the Board on the new development, HCMUD No. 592, and the Board discussed concerns brought up throughout the month.

ENGINEERING MATTERS

Mr. Caraway reported on engineering projects within the District. A copy of the LJA engineering report is attached.

Mr. Caraway reviewed engineering design proposals to rehabilitate the existing lift stations and Water Plant No. 2 in the design amounts of \$100,000.00 and \$92,000.00, respectively.

Mr. Caraway updated the Board on the Water Plant No. 1 recoating and appurtenances and recommended approval of Pay Estimate No. 7 in the amount of \$153,045.00, payable to Pardalis Industrial Enterprises, Inc.

Mr. Caraway updated the Board on the outfall repair and recommended approval in the invoice in the amount of \$66,270.00.

Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to (1) approve the engineering report; (2) approve the engineering design proposals, as discussed; (3) approve the recommended pay estimate; and (4) approve the invoice for the outfall repair. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

LAKE AND TURF MANAGEMENT REPORT, INCLUDING APPROVAL OF PROPOSALS FOR NECESSARY REPAIRS OR REPLACEMENTS, IMPROVEMENTS, RENEWAL OF PERMITS, OR LANDSCAPING AGREEMENTS

Mr. Valladares reviewed a maintenance report, a copy of which is attached.

MASTER PARK PLAN AND FUTURE PARK DEVELOPMENT

The Board reviewed the KGA report, a copy of which is attached.

Ms. Lee updated the Board on the sidewalk enhancement project with Harris County Precinct No. 3 (the "Precinct") and recommended approval of Pay Estimate No. 4 in the amount of \$22,932.00 payable to Strickscapes. Ms. Lee then stated that the Precinct has submitted comments regarding the installation of the sidewalks and presented Change Order No. 1 to increase the contract with Strickscapes in the amount of \$111,880.04 to install handicap ramps and other renovations requested by the Precinct. The Board determined that Change Order No. 1 is beneficial to the District.

Ms. Lee presented and recommended approval of a letter outlining repairs on certain areas of the Villages of Cypress Lakes Homeowners Association ("HOA") property. She noted that the HOA approved and signed the letter.

Ms. Lee discussed potential locations for park signs along the District trails.

Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to (1) approve the KGA report; (2) approve the recommended pay estimate and change order; and (3) authorize execution of the letter with the HOA. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

OPERATION OF DISTRICT FACILITIES AND TERMINATION OF WATER AND SEWER SERVICE TO DELINQUENT CUSTOMERS

Mr. Davila reviewed the operator's report for April 2026, a copy of which is attached.

The Board next considered termination of utility service to delinquent accounts. Mr. Davila reported that the customers on the termination list were mailed written notice prior to this meeting in accordance with the Rate Order, notifying them of the opportunity to appear before the Board of Directors to explain, contest, or correct the utility service bill and to provide an explanation as to why their utility service should not be terminated for reason of nonpayment.

Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved (1) to approve the operator's report; and (2) to terminate utility service in accordance with procedures set forth in the Rate Order, given that the customers on the list were neither present at the meeting nor had they presented any statement on the matter. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

CONSUMER CONFIDENCE REPORT

Mr. Davila reviewed the Consumer Confidence Report ("CCR"), a copy of which is attached to the operator's report, regarding the quality of the District's water and stated that it will be filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") and distributed to District residents by July 1, 2026. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to approve the CCR, authorize the operator to mail the CCR to District customers, and to file the CCR with the TCEQ. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

DISCUSS INFRAMARK'S PROJECT MARKUP AND AUTHORIZE APPROPRIATE ACTION, IF NECESSARY.

Mr. Davila stated that Inframark will provide more information on this matter at the next meeting.

GARBAGE COLLECTION MATTERS

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

WEBSITE MATTERS AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Ms. Dehoyos reviewed the monthly communications report, a copy of which is attached.

UPDATE FROM BOARD COMMITTEES

There was no update on this item.

MEETING DATES AND FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

The Board concurred to hold the next regular meeting on June 8, 2026, at ABHR.

There being no further business to come before them, the Board concurred to adjourn the meeting.

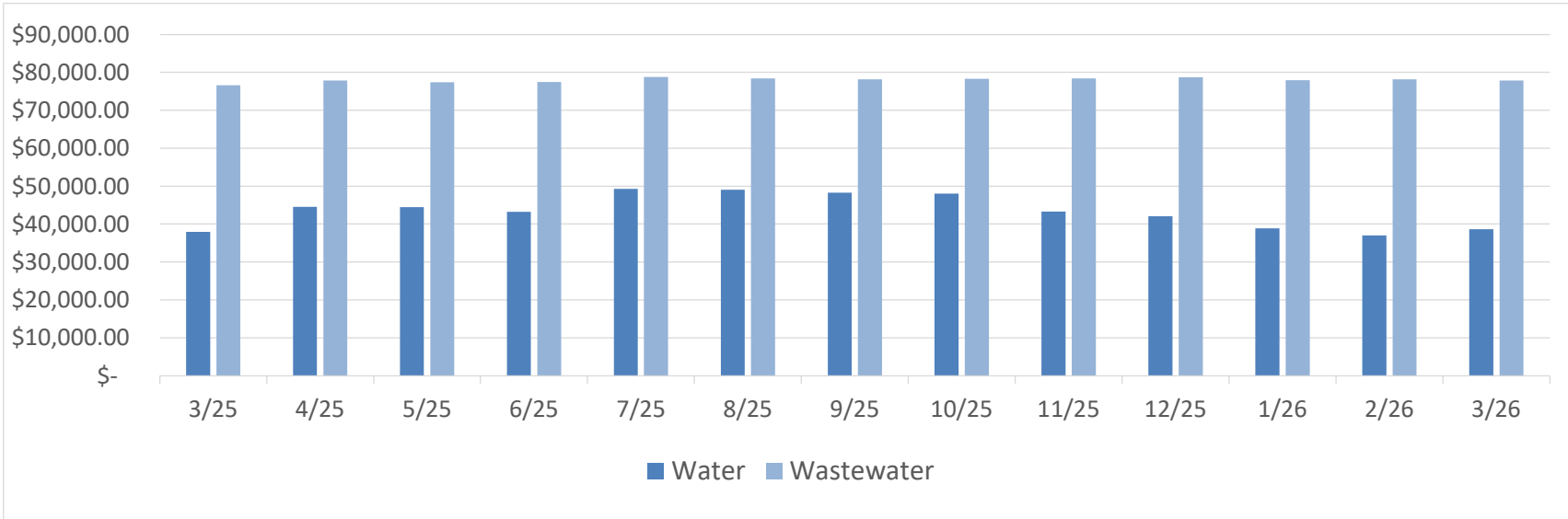

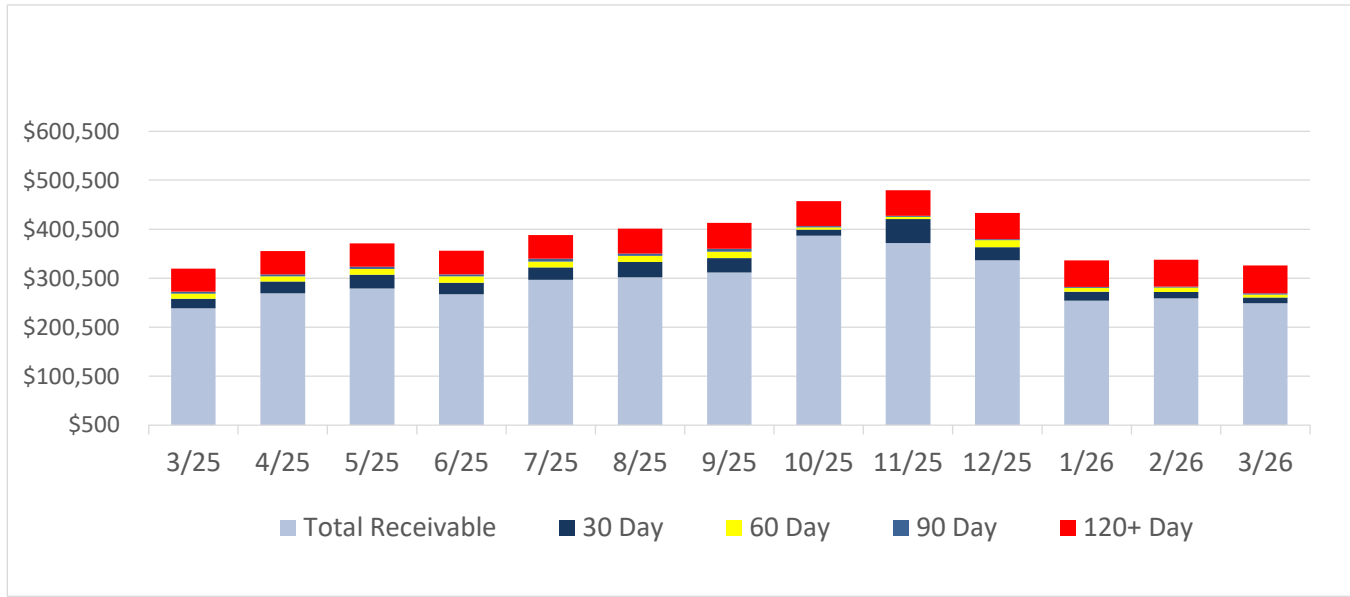

2025 Drinking Water Quality Report

DEAR CUSTOMER:

We are pleased to present you the Annual Water Quality Report (Consumer Confidence Report) for the year, for the period of January 1 to December 31, 2025. This report is intended to provide you with important information about your drinking water and the efforts made by the water system to provide safe drinking water.

The sources of drinking water (both tap water and bottled water) generally include rivers, lakes, streams, ponds, reservoirs, springs, and wells. As water travels over the surface of the land or through the ground, it dissolves naturally-occurring minerals, and in some cases, radioactive material, and can pick up substances resulting from the presence of animals or from human activity.

Drinking water, including bottled water, may reasonably be expected to contain at least small amounts of some contaminants. The presence of contaminants does not necessarily indicate that water poses a health risk. More information about contaminants and potential health effects can be obtained by calling the EPA's Safe Drinking Water Hotline (1-800-426-4791). Contaminants that may be present in the source water include:

- 1) Microbial contaminants, such as viruses and bacteria, which may come from sewage treatment plants, septic systems, agricultural livestock operations, and wildlife.
- 2) Inorganic contaminants, such as salts and metals, which can be naturally-occurring or result from urban storm water runoff, industrial or domestic wastewater discharges, oil and gas production, mining, or farming.
- 3) Pesticides and herbicides, which may come from a variety of sources such as agriculture, urban stormwater runoff, and residential uses.
- 4) Organic chemical contaminants, including synthetic and volatile organic chemicals, which are by-products of industrial processes and petroleum production, and can also, come from gas stations, urban storm water runoff, and septic systems.
- 5) Radioactive contaminants, which can be naturally- occurring or be the result of oil and gas production and mining production and mining activities.

In order to ensure that tap water is safe to drink, EPA prescribes regulations which limit the amount of certain contaminants in water provided by public water systems. FDA regulations establish limits for contaminants in bottled water which must provide the same protection for public health.

Some people may be more vulnerable to contaminants in drinking water than the general population. Contaminants may be found in drinking water that may cause taste, color, or odor problems. Immuno-compromised persons such as persons undergoing chemotherapy for cancer; those who have undergone organ transplants, people with HIV / AIDS or other immune system disorders, some elderly and infants can be particularly at risk from infections. These people should seek advice about drinking water from their health care providers. EPA/CDC guidelines on appropriate means to lessen the risk of infection by Cryptosporidium and other microbial contaminants are available from the Safe Drinking Water Hotline at (800-426-4791).

Lead can cause serious health effects in people of all ages, especially pregnant people, infants (both formula-fed and breastfed), and young children. Lead in drinking water is primarily from materials and parts used in service lines and in home plumbing. Harris County MUD No. 391 is responsible for providing high quality drinking water and removing lead pipes but cannot control the variety of materials used in the plumbing in your home. Because lead levels may vary over time, lead exposure is possible even when your tap sampling results do not detect lead at one point in time. You can help protect yourself and your family by identifying and removing lead materials within your home plumbing and taking steps to reduce your family's risk. Using a filter, certified by an American National Standards Institute accredited certifier to reduce lead, is effective in reducing lead exposures. Follow the instructions provided with the filter to ensure the filter is used properly. Use only cold water for drinking, cooking, and making baby formula.

Boiling water does not remove lead from water. Before using tap water for drinking, cooking, or making baby formula, flush your pipes for several minutes. You can do this by running your tap, taking a shower, doing laundry or a load of dishes. If you have a lead service line or galvanized requiring replacement service line, you may need to flush your pipes for a longer period. Harris County MUD No. 391 the source of drinking water used by Harris County MUD 391 is groundwater from the Evangeline Aquifer.

TCEQ completed an assessment of your source water, and results indicate that our sources have a low susceptibility to contaminants. The sampling requirements for your water system is based on this susceptibility and previous sample data. Any detections of these contaminants will be found in this Consumer Confidence Report. Unregulated Contaminant Monitoring Rule (UCMR): Harris County MUD No. 391 has sampled for a series of unregulated contaminants. Unregulated contaminants are those that don't yet have a drinking water standard set by the EPA. The purpose of monitoring for these contaminants is to help EPA decide whether the contaminants should have a standard. As our customers, you have a right to know that these data are available. The EPA sampled for 30 unregulated chemical contaminants and those contaminants detected in the District's source water are in the data table of the Unregulated Contaminants section of this report.

In the tables below, you will find many terms and abbreviations you might not be familiar with. To help you better understand these terms, we've provided the following definitions:

Action Level (AL): The concentration of a contaminant which, if exceeded, triggers treatment or other requirements which a water system must follow.

Action Level Goal (ALG): The level of a contaminant in drinking water below which there is no known or expected risk to health. ALGs allow for a margin of safety.

Level 1 Assessment: A Level 1 assessment is a study of the water system to identify potential problems and determine (if possible) why total coliform bacteria have been found in our water system.

Level 2 Assessment: A Level 2 assessment is a very detailed study of the water system to identify potential problems and determine (if possible) why an E. coli MCL violation has occurred and/or why total coliform bacteria have been found in our water system on multiple occasions.

Maximum Contaminant Level or MCL: The highest level of a contaminant that is allowed in drinking water. MCLs are set as close to the MCLGs as feasible using the best available treatment technology.

Maximum Contaminant Level Goal or MCLG: The level of a contaminant in drinking water below which there is no known or expected risk to health. MCLGs allow for a margin of safety.

Maximum residual disinfectant level goal or MRDLG: The level of a drinking water disinfectant below which there is no known or expected risk to health. MRDLGs do not reflect the benefits of the use of disinfectants to control microbial contaminants.

Maximum residual disinfectant level or MRDL: The highest level of a disinfectant allowed in drinking water. There is convincing evidence that addition of a disinfectant is necessary for control of microbial contaminants.

Treatment Technique or TT: A required process intended to reduce the level of a contaminant in drinking water.

Variances and Exemptions: State or EPA permission not to meet an MCL or a treatment technique under certain conditions.

Avg: Average - Regulatory compliance with some MCLs are based on running annual average of monthly samples.

RAA: Running Annual Average.

LRAA: Locational Running Annual Average.

mrem: millirems per year (a measure of radiation absorbed by the body).

ppb: micrograms per liter (ug/L) or parts per billion - or one ounce in 7,350,000 gallons of water.

ppm: milligrams per liter (mg/L) or parts per million - or one ounce in 7,350 gallons of water.

picocuries per liter (pCi/L): picocuries per liter is a measure of the radioactivity in water.

na: not applicable.

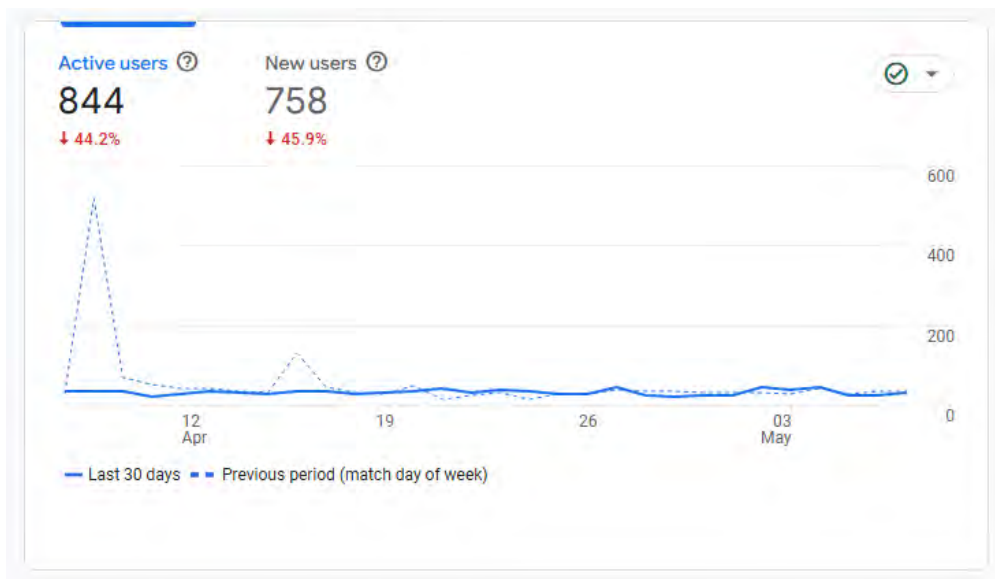

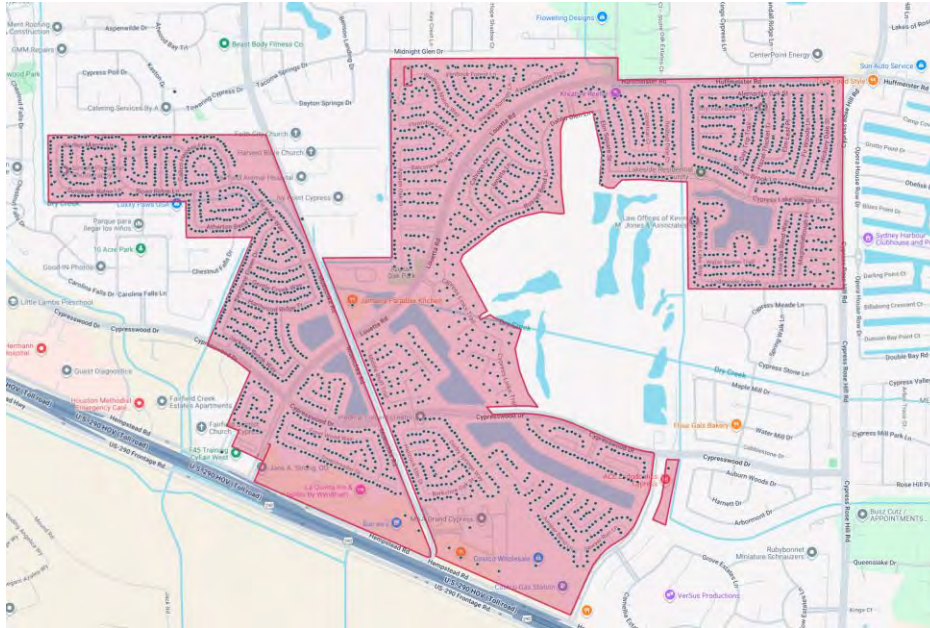
