HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 391

June 8, 2026

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 391 (the "District") met in regular session in person and by videoconference, open to the public, on the 8th day of June, 2026, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Houston, Texas, outside the boundaries of the District, and the roll was called of the members of the Board:

PUBLIC COMMENTS

The Board opened the meeting for public comments.

Mr. Jacob stated concerns regarding the agreement with the development adjacent to the District, also known as Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 592 ("HCMUD No. 592"). He requested the Board consider engaging a third-party engineer to review the current utility agreement. Mr. Jacob then discussed other concerns with consultants of the District and potential projects that would be required under the current utility agreement. A copy of Mr. Jacob's statement is attached.

Mr. Hall introduced himself to the Board and discussed his concerns regarding the utility agreement with HCMUD No. 592. He then requested that the Board consider engaging third-party consultants to review the utility agreement, as well.

Mr. Bhakta introduced himself and discussed his concerns regarding the utility agreement with HCMUD No. 592.

Mr. Hacksworth discussed his concerns regarding the utility agreement with HCMUD No. 592 and agreed with the other public comments provided.

Ms. Jacob discussed her concerns regarding the utility agreement with HCMUD No. 592 and other concerns in the District.

There being no further public comments, the Board moved to the next agenda item.

MINUTES

The Board considered approving the minutes of the May 11, 2026, regular meeting. After review and discussion, Director Blackwell moved to approve the minutes, as presented. Director Porter seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

REORGANIZE THE BOARD AND FILE DISTRICT REGISTRATION FORM

The Board considered reorganizing the Board and filing an updated District Registration Form to reflect the new terms and positions. Following review and discussion, Director McWilliams moved to (1) reorganize the Board as following:

and (2) authorize filing of the District Registration Form. Director Lettries seconded the motion, which passed 3 to 1 with Director Porter voting against the motion and Director Blackwell abstaining from the vote.

SECURITY MATTERS

Sergeant Pleytez and Lieutenant Rodriguez updated the Board on security matters in the District. The Board next discussed the upcoming renewal of the agreement for security and concurred to discuss this further at the next meeting.

FINANCIAL AND BOOKKEEPING MATTERS

Ms. Berry reviewed the bookkeeper's report, a copy of which is attached, and presented the District's bills for payment. Following review and discussion, Director Blackwell moved to approve the bookkeeper's report and payment of the District's bills. Director McWilliams seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

TAX ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTIONS MATTERS

Ms. Arellano reviewed the tax assessor/collector's report, delinquent tax report, and checks presented for payment from the tax account. A copy of the tax assessor/collector's report is attached. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to approve the tax assessor/collector's report and payment of the bills from the tax account. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

AUTHORIZE DELINQUENT TAX ATTORNEY TO PROCEED WITH COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT TAXES

The Board considered authorizing Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, LLP to proceed with the collection of 2025 taxes that are delinquent on July 1, 2026. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to authorize Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, LLP to proceed with the delinquent tax collection when appropriate. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

NEW DEVELOPMENT ADJACENT TO DISTRICT

Mr. Pagan updated the Board on the new development, HCMUD No. 592, and the Board discussed concerns brought up throughout the month.

Mr. Pagan discussed the request for the Board to engage a third-party engineer, and the Board concurred to obtain recommendations for an independent engineer to review the utility agreement with HCMUD No. 592.

The Board then discussed appointing a new liaison to communicate concerns to MAK Development. Following discussion, the Board concurred to appoint Director McWilliams as the liaison with MAK Development.

ENGINEERING MATTERS

Mr. Caraway reported on engineering projects within the District. A copy of the LJA engineering report is attached.

Mr. Caraway updated the Board on the Water Plant No. 1 recoating and appurtenances.

Following review and discussion, Director McWilliams moved to approve the engineering report. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

APPROVE RISK AND RESILIENCE ASSESSMENT

Mr. Caraway reported on certain certification obligations that the District must meet under the America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018 (the "Act"). He stated that, pursuant to the Act, the District must certify to the Environmental Protection Agency that its community water system has completed a Risk and Resilience Assessment (the "Assessment"). Following review and discussion, Director McWilliams moved to approve the Risk and Resilience Assessment, authorize the filing of certification of the Assessment with the Environmental Protection Agency, and direct (i) the Assessment to be filed in confidentially in the District's official records and (ii) the confirmation of certification be filed in the District's official records. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

LAKE AND TURF MANAGEMENT REPORT, INCLUDING APPROVAL OF PROPOSALS FOR NECESSARY REPAIRS OR REPLACEMENTS, IMPROVEMENTS, RENEWAL OF PERMITS, OR LANDSCAPING AGREEMENTS

Mr. Valladares reviewed a maintenance report, a copy of which is attached.

Mr. McIntyre introduced himself to the Board and presented a proposal to replace the control panel for Lake 2, fountain 2 for a cost of \$1,975.00. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to approve the proposal to replace the control panel. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

MASTER PARK PLAN AND FUTURE PARK DEVELOPMENT

The Board reviewed the KGA report, a copy of which is attached. Ms. Lee updated the Board on the sidewalk enhancement project with Harris County Precinct No. 3 (the "Precinct") and recommended approval of Pay Estimate No. 5 in the amount of \$100,692.04 payable to Strickscapes. Ms. Lee then presented Change Order No. 2 to decrease the contract with Strickscapes in the amount of \$25,628.50 for items removed from the scope. The Board determined that Change Order No. 2 is beneficial to the District. Following review and discussion, Director Blackwell moved to (1) approve the KGA report; and (2) approve the recommended pay estimate and change order. Director Lettries seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

OPERATION OF DISTRICT FACILITIES AND TERMINATION OF WATER AND SEWER SERVICE TO DELINQUENT CUSTOMERS

Mr. Davila reviewed the operator's report for May 2026, a copy of which is attached.

The Board next considered termination of utility service to delinquent accounts. Mr. Davila reported that the customers on the termination list were mailed written notice prior to this meeting in accordance with the Rate Order, notifying them of the opportunity to appear before the Board of Directors to explain, contest, or correct the utility service bill and to provide an explanation as to why their utility service should not be terminated for reason of nonpayment.

Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved (1) to approve the operator's report; and (2) to terminate utility service in accordance with procedures set forth in the Rate Order, given that the customers on the list were neither present at the meeting nor had they presented any statement on the matter. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

DISCUSS INFRAMARK'S PROJECT MARKUP AND AUTHORIZE APPROPRIATE ACTION, IF NECESSARY.

Mr. Davila stated that Inframark will provide more information on this matter at the next meeting.

GARBAGE COLLECTION MATTERS

Mr. Farrar reviewed a letter from Best Trash providing notice of the annual Consumer Price Index ("CPI") adjustment to the District's rate for garbage collection services, a copy of which is attached. He noted the letter reflects a CPI adjustment of 4.2%, resulting in an increase in the monthly fee for curbside service with recycling from \$24.62 to \$25.65 per residence, effective for the billing cycle beginning in June 2026 and continuing through May 2027.

WEBSITE MATTERS AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Ms. Dehoyos reviewed the monthly communications report, a copy of which is attached. She then reviewed a proposal to add a website notification system for an initial setup cost of \$3,900.00 and then \$100.00 per month. Following review and discussion, Director McWilliams moved to approve the proposal, as presented. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Ms. Dehoyos then discussed options for posting and operating social media posts.

CONVENE IN EXECUTIVE SESSION FOR CONSULTATION WITH ATTORNEY
PURSUANT TO SECTION 551.071, TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE

The Board convened in Executive Session at 1:16 p.m. to consult with the District's attorneys pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code.

RECONVENE IN OPEN SESSION AND AUTHORIZE APPROPRIATE ACTION

The Board reconvened in open session at 1:28 p.m. No action was taken by the Board.

UPDATE FROM BOARD COMMITTEES AND ASSIGNMENTS

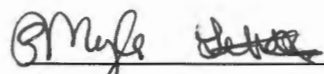

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Statement to MUD 391

June 8, 2026

My name is Paul Jacob, and I am the President of the Villages of Cypress Lakes HOA. After today's meeting, these prepared remarks will be shared electronically with our HOA and this MUD Board.

Imagine waking up one day and being informed that you can no longer use your tap water because it was contaminated. Or that your MUD tax bill will be 25% higher because excess costs from another property outside our district were imposed on us. And the people meant to protect our community from these harms instead allowed them to happen for reasons that are impossible to understand. The utility agreement that this Board authorized in July 2024, or more simply put, the deal that gave our excess water capacity to the golf course development, which isn't even part of our District, puts us at risk of these things. In the past our community has asked this Board to cancel the agreement and has never received a response to this request. The Board simply issued a statement outlining why the water deal was beneficial to our community but there is nothing in that statement that makes it clear that it is beneficial.

So here we are now. The recent election was overwhelmingly in favor of a change in direction with the new Board members receiving multiples of the votes that the incumbents received. And hopefully today we will have a new President to further demonstrate the change that the community voted for. Almost a year ago, residents of this District came out by the hundreds to protest the Utility Agreement with MAK, hoping the prior Board would re-examine the agreement and cancel it if the risks and costs warranted doing so. Now that the community has again voiced its concerns through action, I am asking the new MUD 391 Board to take these concerns seriously.

The Board should immediately retain a qualified, independent, third-party engineering firm to examine the risks of the Utility Agreement and the future costs to MUD 391. The prior Board relied on the same engineering firm, RG Miller, and the same law firm, ABHR, that were also associated with MAK. There was no truly independent investigation of the risks associated with this deal, and it puts our water and tax rate at risk.

The new Board has a responsibility to the entire MUD 391 community to review this matter thoroughly using independent resources, not parties connected to the developer, before any connections are made. At a minimum, the Board should:

- Order an independent engineering review;
- Require updated capacity modeling for the District's water and wastewater systems;
- Examine whether the necessary TCEQ waivers are sustainable, particularly given that the agreement contemplates use of the wastewater plant at 100% of operable capacity;
- Determine the future cost of any water or wastewater expansions that may be required;

- Investigate whether the operational assumptions underlying the agreement were flawed;
- Examine flows into existing MUD 391 detention, including the system along Iron Rose Court in Leyland Shores, to determine whether post-development flows will remain at or below prior flows, as required;
- Review conflicts and process issues surrounding approval of the agreement;
- Evaluate whether drought conditions, surface water conversion, or current water supply constraints materially changed the assumptions behind the agreement;
- Evaluate whether imminent FEMA floodplain changes require the developer to create additional detention capacity;
- Examine the surface profile to determine whether surrounding communities may experience increased runoff;
- Appraise all costs to MUD 391 resulting from this deal, including future capacity expansions, metering needed to monitor MAK's flows, backup water solutions such as the Fairfield pipeline connection previously discussed, and any other costs identified by the independent engineer; and
- Compare the costs and risks to MUD 391 against the potential downside of cancelling the agreement and facing possible litigation.

The Board should also scrutinize the claims previously used to justify this agreement. Aside from the \$2.95 million consideration, which may be offset or exceeded by new costs, the prior Board stated that other developers were ready to build on the land without MUD 391's water and that multifamily development was possible. County Permitting informed us that the land is restricted from multifamily construction. I also submitted a public information request to MUD 391 regarding other developer's interest in the property, and the response I received indicates there is no documentation establishing that any such interest existed.

I also want to raise concern about using LJA, the MUD's new engineering firm, to conduct this review. LJA has previously been the subject of serious allegations in the Elm Grove flooding case, including allegations involving flawed modeling, outdated criteria, and inadequate drainage analysis. I have brought copies of those materials for the Board's consideration. Given the seriousness of the issues here, the investigation should be handled by a firm with no connection to the developer and no appearance of bias.

The agreement itself also raises serious cost concerns. Contrary to what ABHR stated at the last meeting, MAK does not appear to have an obligation to pay its full proportionate share of operation and maintenance costs before a certain number of connections are established. That includes projects such as the roof project discussed at the last meeting, estimated at approximately \$1 million. This is highly concerning. The agreement puts MUD 391 on the hook for 83% of future shared facility costs, even though our District is otherwise fully built out and already has enough capacity to serve our own needs without any future expansion. Any additional costs required to expand facilities, create backup water solutions, or monitor MAK's new connections should have been fully paid by the new

development, not by existing MUD 391 residents. This is one of the clearest flaws in the agreement.

Before Rachel Broom's term ended, she identified two additional projects she said were necessary to de-risk the agreement. One was a pipeline connection into Fairfield's freshwater system to provide backup capacity in the event of water curtailment, similar to what we recently experienced when one of our wells was down. That project was described as costing approximately \$500,000. She also discussed a metering project to ensure MAK's wastewater flows do not exceed the agreement's thresholds, also estimated at approximately \$500,000. My understanding is that MAK would not be responsible for either of these costs, even though they are only imposed on MUD 391 because of the Utility Agreement. If the TCEQ does not grant a waiver on the wastewater plant, to operate at 100% of capacity, and an expansion is required, it could be north of \$4 million based on the last time we expanded that facility. A freshwater well is just under \$6 million based on comments from a recent MUD meeting. Even considering MAK's 17% share, all in our MUD could conceivably face \$10 million of additional costs, and it could be a lot more than that.

Given the significant expense required for MUD 391 to restructure or protect its infrastructure to handle MAK's load, the Board should officially determine whether the \$2.95 million consideration is more than offset by costs that would never have been required had this agreement not been signed. If those costs exceed the consideration, then the prior claim that this deal benefits MUD 391 should be revised or replaced with a transparent statement acknowledging the true financial impact. The MUD should examine whether litigation costs would exceed the future costs of this agreement and any risks we undertake by moving forward with the connections. And if it is determined that the financial and engineering risks to our MUD exceed the downside of litigation, this Board should have the courage to cancel the agreement.

All of these issues should be investigated fully, independently, and transparently. Meanwhile, any connections under consideration between the development and our water systems should be placed on hold until this investigation can be performed. Our community deserves a complete accounting of the risks, costs, assumptions, and alternatives.

My hope is that this Board takes the matter seriously. If MUD 391 experiences water contamination, capacity failures, tax hikes, or flooding, this Board will have had the responsibility and opportunity to act before those harms occurred, and is ultimately responsible. Please do the right thing for the sake of our community. Thank you.

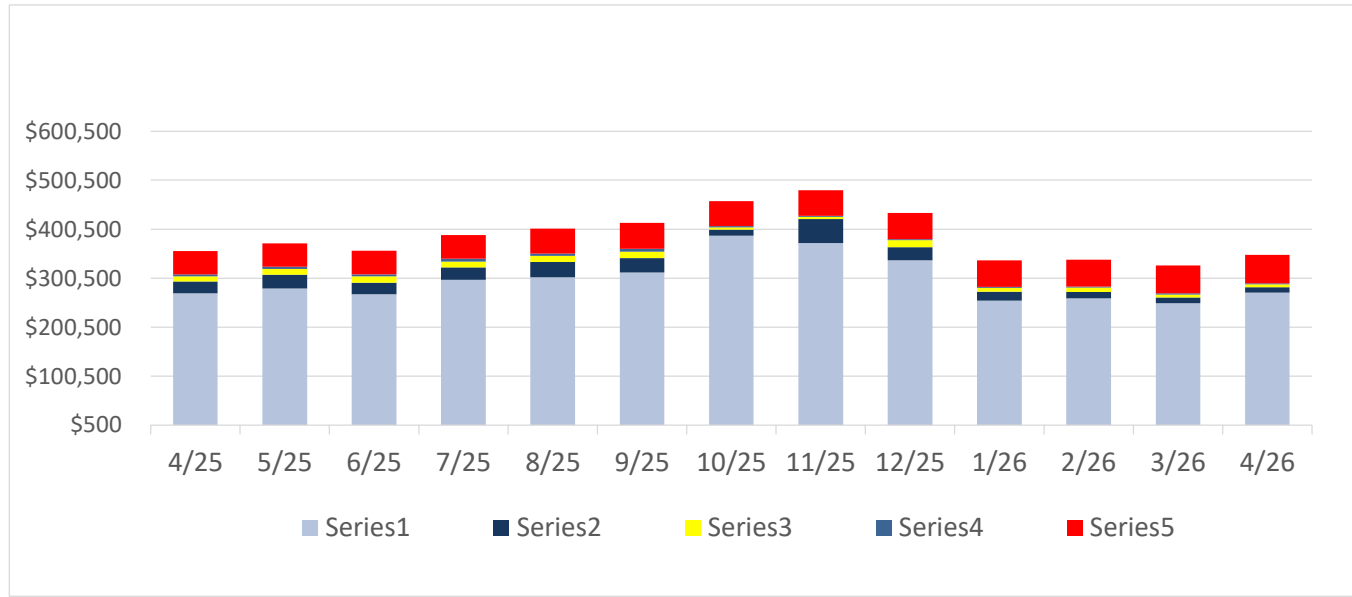
