

MINUTES
HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 391

April 13, 2026

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 391 (the "District") met in regular session in person and by videoconference, open to the public, on the 13th day of April, 2026, at the La Quinta Inn & Suites, 27130 Highway 290, Cypress, TX 77429, inside the boundaries of the District, and the roll was called of the members of the Board:

and all of the above were present, thus constituting a quorum.

Also present at the meeting were Sonia DeSouza, Paul Jacob, and Megan Jacob, residents of the District attending by videoconference; Chris McWilliams, Myla Lettries, and Carol Gibbons, residents of the District attending in person; Sargent Pleytez and Lieutenant Rodriquez of the Harris County Constables; Sarah Valladares of Storm Water Solutions, LLC ("SWS"); Simon Van Dyk, Danae Dehoyos, and Calep Estes of Touchstone District Services; Cole Caraway of LJA Engineering ("LJA"); Demitra Berry of McLennan & Associates, LP ("McLennan"); Stephanie Lee of KGA/Deforest Design, LLC ("KGA"); Debbie Arellano of Bob Leared Interests; Randy Davila of Inframark Water & Infrastructure Services ("Inframark"); and Greer Pagan, Elizabeth Cone, and Kerri Houck of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP ("ABHR").

PUBLIC COMMENTS

The Board opened the meeting for public comments.

Mr. McWilliams introduced himself and discussed concerns regarding the posting of the minutes on the District's website. He then inquired regarding the audio quality of meetings held at ABHR.

Mr. Jacob stated concerns regarding the sidewalk project that is partnered with Harris County Precinct 3. He requested that the District provide a letter to the Villages of Cypress Lakes Homeowners Association ("HOA") formally requesting access to the HOA's property. Mr. Jacob also requested that all landscaping, including sod and trees, be returned to its original condition.

There being no further public comments, the Board moved to the next agenda item.

MINUTES

The Board considered approving the minutes of the March 16, 2026, regular meeting and the March 25, 2026, special meeting. After review and discussion, Director Shook moved to approve the minutes, as presented. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

TAX ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTIONS MATTERS

Ms. Arellano reviewed the tax assessor/collector's report, delinquent tax report, and checks presented for payment from the tax account. A copy of the tax assessor/collector's report is attached. Following review and discussion, Director Shook moved to approve the tax assessor/collector's report and payment of the bills from the tax account. Director Force seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

SECURITY MATTERS

The Board discussed security matters in the District and discussion ensued regarding traffic violations at certain intersections in the District.

FINANCIAL AND BOOKKEEPING MATTERS

Ms. Berry reviewed the bookkeeper's report, a copy of which is attached, and presented the District's bills for payment. She reported that one of the District's bond accounts will be eligible to close after the final payment. Following review and discussion, Director Broom moved to approve the bookkeeper's report and payment of the District's bills, including closing the bond account, as discussed. Director Force seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

NEW DEVELOPMENT ADJACENT TO DISTRICT

Director Broom reviewed information provided by MAK Development, the developer of the development adjacent to the District, also known as Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 592 ("HCMUD No. 592"), and discussed concerns brought up throughout the month.

ENGINEERING MATTERS

Mr. Caraway reported on engineering projects within the District. A copy of the LJA engineering report is attached.

Mr. Caraway updated the Board on the water plant no. 1 recoating and appurtenances and discussion ensued regarding the current rental unit at the facility.

Mr. Caraway presented an updated Capital Improvements Plan, a copy of which is attached to the engineering report.

Mr. Caraway discussed the emergency repair at water plant no. 2, and the Board concurred to contract directly with the contractor to complete the repair.

Following review and discussion, Director Broom moved to approve the engineering report. Director Blackwell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

LAKE AND TURF MANAGEMENT REPORT, INCLUDING APPROVAL OF PROPOSALS FOR NECESSARY REPAIRS OR REPLACEMENTS, IMPROVEMENTS, RENEWAL OF PERMITS, OR LANDSCAPING AGREEMENTS

Ms. Valladares then reviewed a maintenance report, a copy of which is attached.

The Board discussed lake and turf management matters and reviewed a proposal from Lake Pro, Inc. to replace fountain no. 2 at lake no. 2 for a cost of \$15,975.00. Following review and discussion, Director Porter moved to approve the proposal to replace the fountain. Director Force seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

MASTER PARK PLAN AND FUTURE PARK DEVELOPMENT

The Board reviewed the KGA report, a copy of which is attached. Ms. Lee updated the Board on the sidewalk enhancement project with Harris County Precinct No. 3 (the "Precinct"). Ms. Lee stated that the Precinct has submitted comments regarding the installation of the sidewalks and that she will present a change order at the next meeting incorporating the Precinct's comments. Discussion ensued regarding preparing a letter addressed to the HOA requesting their consent to the encroachments. Mr. Pagan stated that he will speak directly to Mr. Jacob regarding the letter.

OPERATION OF DISTRICT FACILITIES AND TERMINATION OF WATER AND SEWER SERVICE TO DELINQUENT CUSTOMERS

Mr. Davila reviewed the operator's report for March 2026, a copy of which is attached. Discussion ensued regarding the District's interconnect with Cypress Hill Municipal Utility District No. 1 and if there were other options for interconnection.

The Board next considered termination of utility service to delinquent accounts. Mr. Davila reported that the customers on the termination list were mailed written notice prior to this meeting in accordance with the Rate Order, notifying them of the opportunity to appear before the Board of Directors to explain, contest, or correct the

utility service bill and to provide an explanation as to why their utility service should not be terminated for reason of nonpayment.

Following review and discussion, Director Broom moved (1) to approve the operator's report; and (2) to terminate utility service in accordance with procedures set forth in the Rate Order, given that the customers on the list were neither present at the meeting nor had they presented any statement on the matter. Director Force seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

APPROVE RISK AND RESILIENCE ASSESSMENT

Mr. Caraway stated that this item is currently being completed by LJA.

GARBAGE COLLECTION MATTERS

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

WEBSITE MATTERS AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Ms. Dehoyos reviewed the monthly communications report, a copy of which is attached.

UPDATE FROM BOARD COMMITTEES


The Board discussed updates from each committee.

MEETING DATES AND FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

The Board concurred to hold the next regular meeting on May 11, 2026, at ABHR.

There being no further business to come before them, the Board concurred to adjourn the meeting.

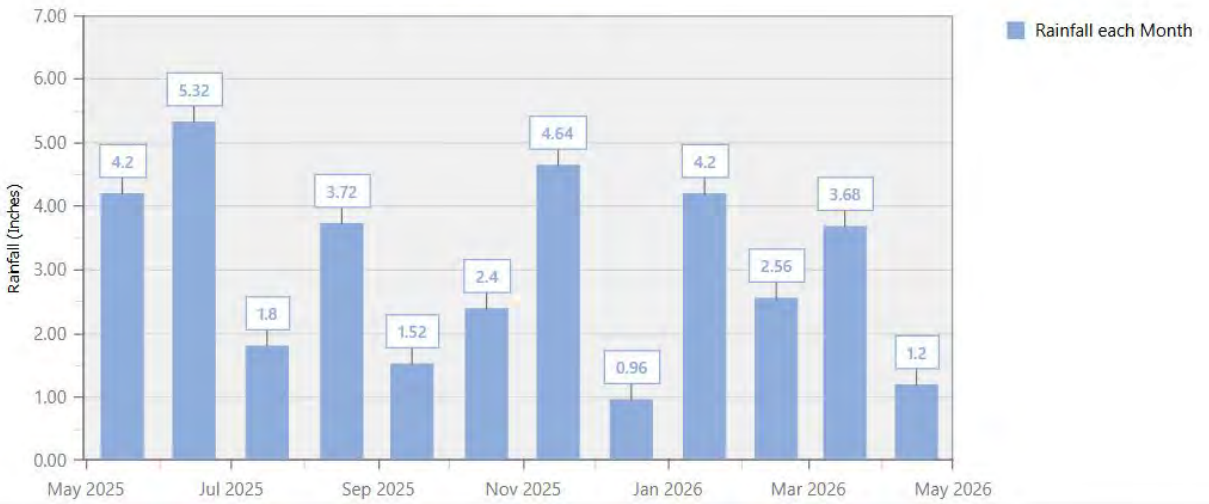
HCMUD 391 Overall Map

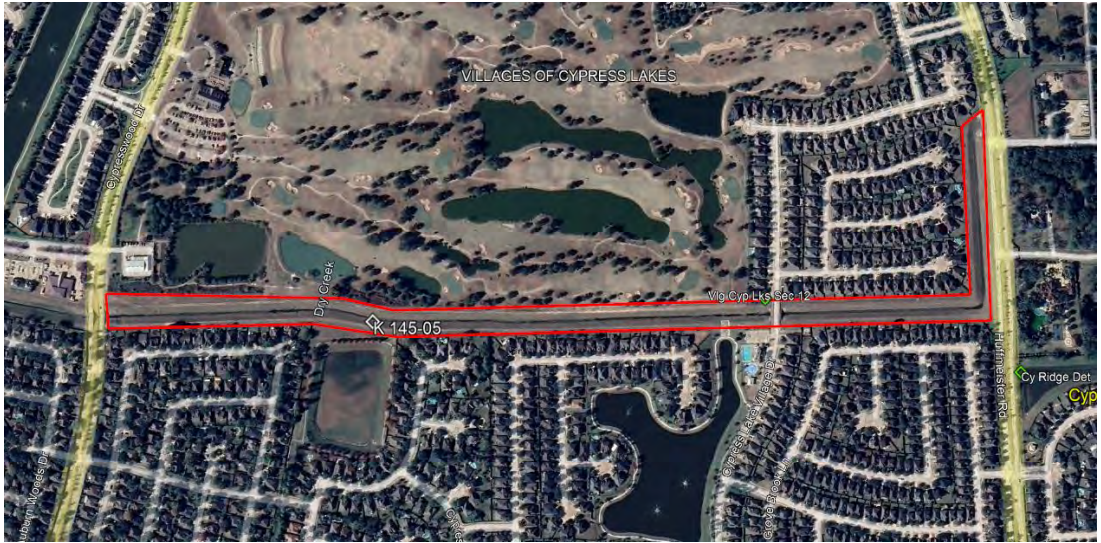

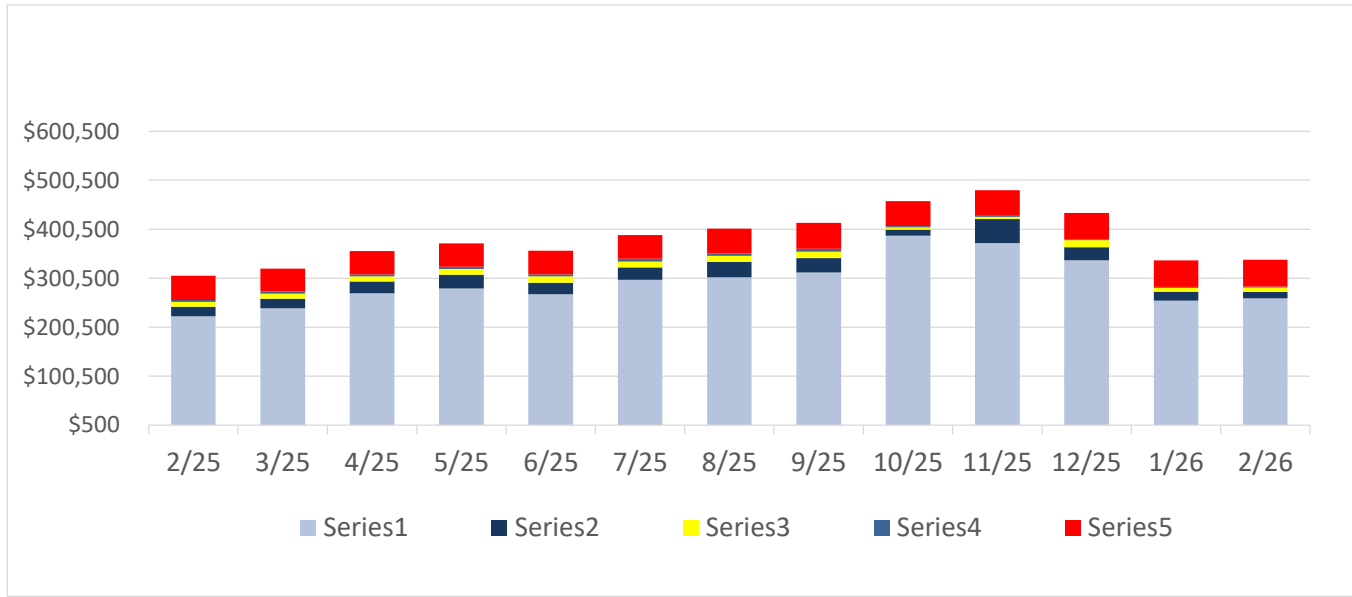

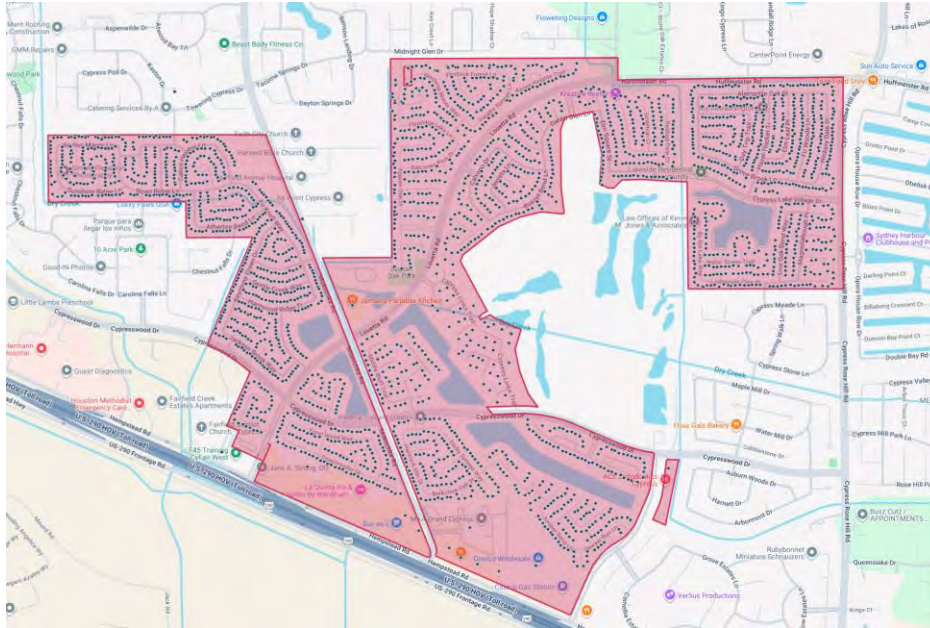
